ABODE COMMUNITIES' BEYOND HOMES SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

GUIDE FOR APPLICANTS

This guide provides you with instructions on how to register for the scholarships portal at the California Community Foundation, how to confirm your registration, and provides helpful tips on filling out the application. A preview of the scholarship application is provided at the end of this guide, should you prefer to prepare your answers offline and then copy/paste them into the online application.

In short, here is a summary of the application process:

1. Register as an applicant in the scholarships portal
2. Confirm registration in your email
3. Navigate to the scholarship application in the portal
4. Fill out the application and submit

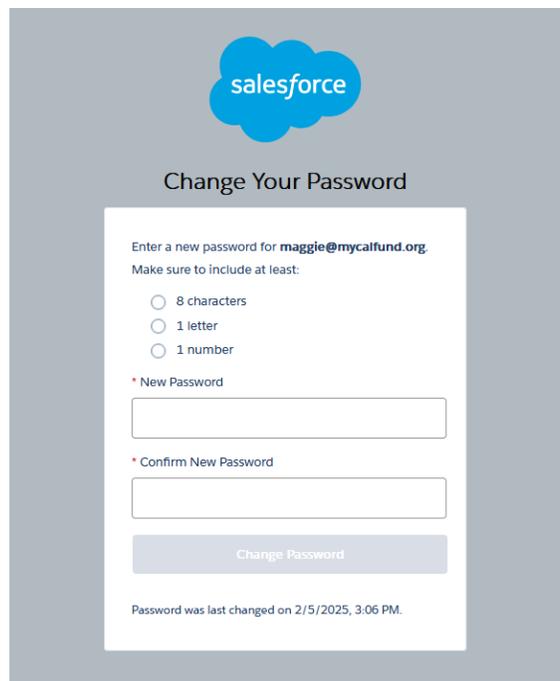

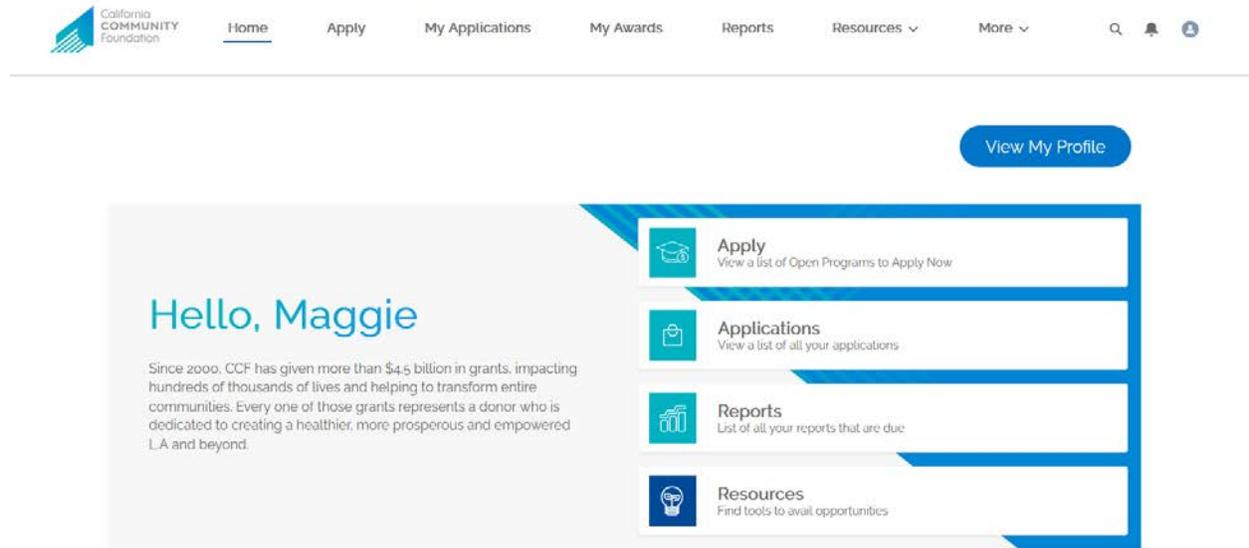

The link in the email will prompt you to create a password:



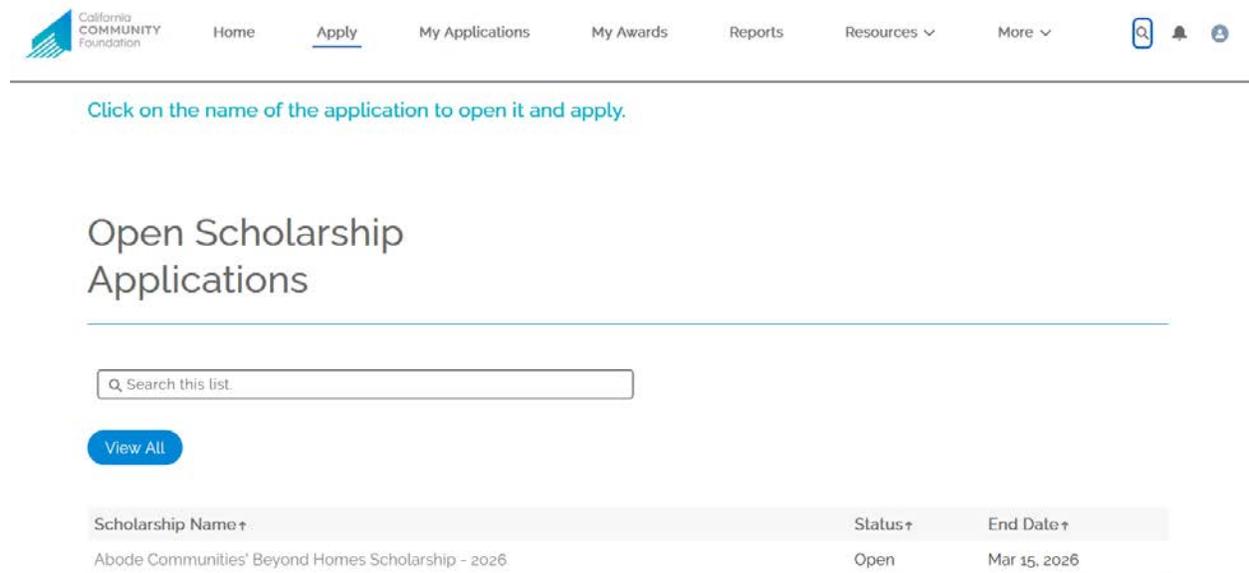
You will then be taken to the home screen of the application portal:

Description

Established in 2008, this fund awards college scholarships to disadvantaged youth that live in an Abode Communities property.

Once you click on the name of the scholarship, you'll need to click on the "Apply Now" button. This will take you to the main application page.

You may work on your application and save your progress as you go, but you must have information in all of the required fields (marked with a red asterisk) in order to save the application as a draft. You may put placeholder information into the required fields and return to the application if you save it as a draft. It is recommended you prepare your answers offline and then paste them into the fields when you are ready to submit. A copy of the application is provided at the end of this guide.

You can return to your saved application on the My Applications page on the scholarship portal. Your saved draft will reopen when you click on your application ID.

In order to successfully submit your application, you must provide 1) all required information 2) all required attachments and 3) when your application has been finalized you must type your name into the box at the bottom of the application, select “yes”, and click Submit. You will receive a submission confirmation email.

When you view your submitted application on the portal, you will **not** be able to see your file submissions or checkboxes. If you are missing materials after you’ve submitted your application, the Foundation will contact you. If you’d like to confirm receipt of materials, please contact scholarships@calfund.org.

Tips:

- Please use an email that you check regularly. Please **avoid** providing a school-associated e-mail address if you will be transferring schools.
- We may need to send you information by mail. Be sure to include your full mailing address which should include your street address (ex. 2000 Smith Street), your city (ex. Los Angeles), your five-digit postal zip code (ex. 90012), and if applicable an apartment or unit number. Please **only** put the country of United States in the Country box.
- It is permissible to consult an adult and seek guidance on the essay portion of the application. It is the committee’s expectation that you are the sole author of your essay and that you have not received assistance in editing your essay by an adult or peer. If you are quoting another individual, be sure to properly cite and identify direct quotes using quotation marks.
- If you have any clarifying questions, seek guidance from a counselor or teacher. If they are unable to assist you – contact the Foundation at scholarships@calfund.org and we will do our best to address your question in a timely fashion.

Abode Communities' Beyond Homes Scholarship

Description: Abode Communities is deeply committed to ensuring its residents have the resources, tools, and support needed to achieve higher education.

Amount and Criteria: In addition to the higher education and career planning services offered through Abode Communities' resident services program, Beyond Homes, the organization offers two unique academic scholarship opportunities for young adults to pursue a two- or four-year college, university, vocational/trade school, or certificate program:

- Building Hope Fund – \$2,500 per year, up to \$10,000 for graduating high school seniors with a minimum GPA of 3.5
- Building Equity Fund - \$2,500 per year, up to \$5,000 for students ages 17-28 with a minimum GPA of 2.0 or a GED Score of 400 who have demonstrated experience with, or a commitment to Black, Indigenous, and/or other communities of Color

Instructions: PLEASE SUBMIT ONLY (1) APPLICATION. APPLICANTS DO NOT NEED TO SUBMIT TWO APPLICATIONS. Abode Communities' Scholarship Committee will make fund assignments upon candidate evaluation.

All scholarship awards are made directly to the educational institution and can be used to pay for tuition, books, living expenses, and more!

You will be required to submit the following application components:

- Academic achievements
- Community activities
- Essay questions
- Letters of recommendation
- Building Hope Fund: Two (2) signed letters of recommendation. Building Equity Fund: Two (2) signed letters from persons who can speak on behalf of your character, goals, motivation, achievements. Letter cannot be from a family member.
- Current school transcript (If selected for an interview, an official high school transcript for the Building Hope Fund or official documentation of past high school graduation or GED test scores for the Building Equity Fund will be required to determine eligibility.)

Deadline:

- Application Opens: February 1, 2026
- Unofficial transcripts must be dated no earlier than: February 1, 2026
- Application Closes: March 15, 2026

PLEASE NOTE, ANY APPLICATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
